What type of cistern qualifies?

New Installation (after 3/2/15)
Refurbished Existing (Non-functioning)
Septic Tank Conversion

How much \$\$ can I get back?

Customers will be reimbursed at the rate of
up to \$1 per gallon of usable rainwater
storage capacity, to a maximum of \$500.

How do I apply?

1. Obtain pre-approval from FKAA. Application available from FKAA offices or at FKAA.com.
2. Complete all work and submit final application and documentation before September 30, 2018.

Funding is limited, and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis upon receipt of Final Application.
One rebate per property, max \$500 per customer.
Installations mandated by Key West Ordinance are not eligible.

How Much Rainwater Can You Collect?

A 2,000 square-foot roof can capture
1,200 gallons of water during a 1" rain.

Conservation Benefits

The addition of just 55 cisterns in Monroe County could reduce water demand by one million gallons per year. As cisterns are added to homes and neighborhoods, community awareness increases, which we hope will inspire long-term behavioral changes favoring water conservation and environmental stewardship.




Septic Tank to Cistern Conversion

One of the benefits of connecting to the Central Wastewater System is the opportunity it provides to convert your septic tank into a cistern.

The conversion process is easier than you may think! After the septic tank is pumped, pressure-cleaned, disinfected and inspected, you will need to install roof gutters, a downspout, and a pump with a pressure tank. Once the pump is connected to power, water funneled from the roof is collected in the tank and distributed via a faucet or through your landscaping system as needed.

For slightly more than the cost of the required septic tank abandonment, you can utilize your tank to capture rainwater for use in landscape watering, car washing, boat washing, motor flushing, and pressure-washing. In doing so you're not only conserving a precious resource, but you're also reducing your water and wastewater bills for years to come.
